Lunch in one of Oswego's restaurants while viewing the Oswego River and Harbor on Great Lake Ontario.

**Ontario Orchards** in the town of Oswego is one of New York State's largest and most complete farms, farm markets and nurseries. Open year round, Ontario Orchards is family owned, specializing in locally grown produce in season, a year-round cider mill, in-house bakery, garden center, greenhouses, and a complete nursery.

*3:45-5 p.m.*

Meet the **Willow Creek Farm Alpacas**, where over a dozen alpacas will greet you. Shop in the farm store for items made from luxurious alpaca fiber including alpaca yarn, capes, scarves, hats, gloves, plus cuddly teddy bears and finger puppets. A spinning demonstration shows how the fleece is transformed into yarn. The farm also features homemade maple syrup.
