

Adirondack Kennel Sled Dog Rides

What to expect and bring with you.

Adirondack kennel was established in 1991 in the Southern Adirondacks and since has moved here to Central New York for the past 10 years.

We use predominantly the Scandinavian Hound, a hybrid sled dog used for their superior brain, power, speed and general toughness and health. They are a mix of German Pointer, Alaskan husky, greyhound and various hunting hounds; a very approachable dog with great personalities.

The 'gear' you will need to bring is obviously a warm pair of boots, gloves and winter clothing associated with Central NY winters. If possible sunglasses or ski goggles, etc. we can supply a limited number of goggles. Adirondack Kennel will supply a blanket (if desired) and all the comforts such as pillows, etc. to make your ride enjoyable and warm.

The ride will be approximately 40-45 minutes in total duration and will include one 10 minute stop where all the dogs are let loose to rest, roam around and you can take photos, pass out doggie treats and pick a favorite dog.

We will be traversing the beautiful Winona Forest Preserve, a mix of woods and old logging roads and is generally rolling terrain (www.winonaforest.com).

CD of your experience (mixed stills and movies) is also available for an additional \$8.00. Approximate length usually 10 minutes of video and several dozen photos.
