11:30 a.m.

Arrive for a tour of the The Bristol Hill Church. Listed on New York State's Underground Railroad Heritage Trail, the New York State and National Register of Historic Places, and the National Park Services National Underground Railroad Network to Freedom.

1:00 p.m.

Lunch at Sweet Inspirations. Go back to the 50's with this fun restaurant; great food and great desserts.

2:30 p.m.

Take a guided tour of Lock #3 on the Oswego Canal. Learn what it takes to operate a lock and you may even get to see a lock operator in action! This is a seasonal venue.

3:30-5:00 p.m.

Arrive at the John Wells Pratt House for a guided tour of Fulton's history with permanent and changing exhibits on area history, industries, and people. Features a restored kitchen and telephone switchboard.

5:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Relax and enjoy dinner at the end of the day at one of Fulton's fine restaurants such as Tavern on the Lock Restaurant & Bar.
