

Visit the **Willow Creek Farm Alpacas**, where over a dozen alpacas will greet you. Shop in the farm store for items made from luxurious alpaca fiber including alpaca yarn, capes, hats, scarves, gloves, plus cuddly teddy bears and finger puppets. A spinning demonstration shows how the fleece is transformed into yarn. The farm also features homemade maple syrup.

Come to Ozzie's Antiques & Country Co-op,

a beautiful 1740s farmhouse with 17 rooms filled with antiques, folk art, primitives, kitchenware, birdhouses, and garden amenities. Browse their perennial gardens and relax in the Country Victorian Tea Room and veranda.

Lunch in one of Oswego's restaurants while viewing the Oswego River and harbor on Great Lake Ontario.

Stop at **Ontario Orchards** in the town of Oswego, one of New York State's largest and most complete farms, farm markets and nurseries. Open year-round, Ontario Orchards is family-owned and features local seasonal produce, a year-round cider mill, an in-house bakery, garden center, greenhouses, and nursery.
